- VI. **President Morning tea** Lisa said it was a good meet & greet, two speakers Scott Windus grew te nnis in Cambodia which was wonderful to hear about the obstacles they have faced and conquered, A international Umpire also spoke. They then were invited to watch the ATP cup Serbai vs Chile game.
- VII. Canada cheer squad Myleigh was lucky enough to win a social media competition to be the official Canada cheer squad for the ATP cup. She received 20 tickets to support Canada vs Greece. She asked many members to show the club colours with Coach Nick and Lisa attending as well as our club sponsors DDS, JPL junior teams etc. They were able to catch up with Jon Krause at the event also.
- VIII. Masterclass Myleigh and Lauren attended this and reported on such a wonderful informative class. Guest speakers from park run were full of ideas. The class focused on embracing the digital side to help our volunteer roles easier and make tennis more accessible to the community. Focus on the new program "Open court sessions" with the statistics of number dwindling from 14+, The focus was very much on encouraging & supporting volunteering and making each role as easy as possible. The girls then were able to watch Barty in her first match for Brisbane International.
- IX. Vending machine Katie working on quotes, one supplier suggested it is more financially viable for the club to buy a machine and stock it as we make 100% profit, this supplier gave prices of \$800 for non-card drink machine. Combination machine \$6k brand new with eftpos. It was unanimous that it must have eftpos. Katie to obtain guotes and follow up.
- X. Fencing Darren thanked those who were able to come help with fence after storm. Darren has insurance claims rolling, quote from coastwire- demolish damaged fence and erect 3m black coat, (Darren to follow up regarding large gate) \$17345. Unanimously moved to start repairs
- XI. **Sign on day** Overall had a lot of interest in coaching and junior memberships done. Myleigh was disappointed that the senior sign up didn't attend and suggested that in future it is all done at one event to make it easier for volunteers. Darren felt doing it online took too long as too many people were waiting, Myleigh mentioned the difficulty had with internet connection.
